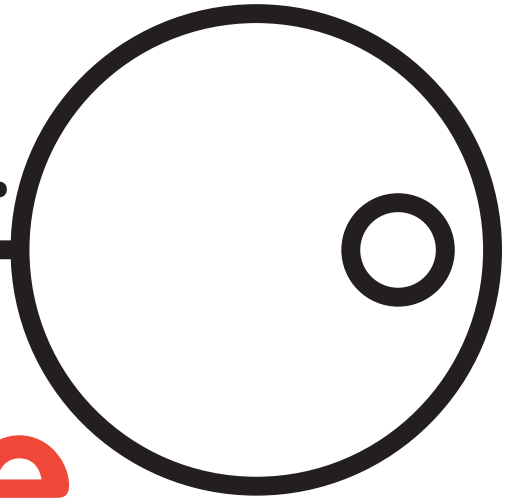


REFUGEE FREEDOM KEY

some issues are larger than nations, some issues are about being human and how we care for each other as people, regardless of where we have come from.

an invitation to all south australians to come in peace to express humane opposition to the injustice asylum seekers face in this country. the punishment of people who are in search of refuge contradicts the most basic of human rights – and in australia in particular we have cherished the rights of ‘a fair go’ and a fresh start. the injustice shown towards asylum seekers must end.

come along, rattle your keys, creatively display a key (wear it as jewellery), use a key as a gesture of freedom that shows your heart is open.

wear your keys

wear your key... as a necklace...
a brooch... an anklet...

rattle your keys

rattle your keys... use the keys on your key ring along with other peoples in a chorus of ringing keys. start a ripple effect so that in time it becomes known as a refugee freedom gesture. start it at the fringe parade, continue it at home, down the street, in a café, before or after a performance, at any gathering. have the key become a public and private gesture of freedom.
